The joys? of horse shopping

Looking for a new horse, at least for me, is not an enjoyable activity. It's one thing to go along as an observer for someone else. You get to see a lot of different horses, take photos and videos for a friend, and sort of window shop. But when you're the one who is in need of a new partner it's a whole different ball game.

About 2 years ago, Ziggy, my Shire cross, started having some medical issues which unfortunately are not correctable. I started half-heartedly looking at ads all the while just being able to play with him. It finally reached a point where I was really missing the riding aspect of horse ownership so I started searching in earnest.

My situation is probably similar to some of you. I've ridden for years but as time has gone on I've become rather timid and since this will be my last horse I don't want to make a wrong choice. I tend to keep my horses and there are just so many stalls in the barn! I've been lucky in that the majority of horses I've owned were the right temperament for me-laid back, easy-going, not super sensitive but yet not dead-heads.

Before the Internet made horse shopping easier, you had to read all the classifieds in both newspapers and magazines, visit the tack shops and feed stores to check bulletin boards, and then spend hours driving from one farm to another in the hopes of finding the right horse.

Now you not only can see a photo but quite often there will be videos as well which does make it easier to narrow down choices. But you still have to see the horse in person, so driving all over creation is not eliminated.

In my case, finding a replacement for Saint Ziggy (as a friend of mine calls him) is daunting. He's the horse who restored my confidence after losing faith in my riding ability when a previous horse launched me into the air. While not necessarily a dressage star, he's exactly what I need

both under saddle and on the ground-an in your pocket kind of guy and one who takes care of me. Add to that the fact that all the horses I've felt most at home on have been of the wide variety. While I know that this body type is not ideal for my shorter legs, it's what I've been comfortable with for years. And because of Zig I've become enamored of draft crosses.

I've run the gamut searching ads from 4yo to 15yo, 14.3h to 16h, gelding or mare, trail horses, pleasure horses, dressage, hunters, and everything else in between. I've lost count of how many "horse for sale" websites I've bookmarked. It's become almost an obsession, checking them multiple times a day, hoping some new ad will pop up. Getting to watch videos has been a big help in eliminating those who wouldn't suit.

For the most part, the sellers have been very forthcoming when I've called or emailed. I always say that I'm not a bold rider and that my first requirement is temperament. Generally, I think they've not tried to get me to look at a horse that would be a little too "sparky" for me. However, this whole process has gotten rather old and I'm ready for it to be over.

So where am I in my search? Well, I may have found one that's promising. While I'm not a superstitious person, I'm not going into any details at this point. If things turn out favorably, you will hear about it in an upcoming issue. ☺

Member of the Month

VADA/Nova's member of the month for the month of April is Mark Foulon. Mark and his family moved to Potomac, MD 15 years ago. He has one son, Benjamin, who has graduated from college and now lives in New Jersey. He also has a daughter, Jennifer, who is

currently studying at Princeton, when she is not in Florida for the winter or somewhere else for a horse show.

Originally from Spokane, Washington, Mark went to school in Connecticut, and moved to the DC area in 1983 to join the State Department. He spent ten years as a Foreign Service Officer, mostly in the Middle East, living in such places as Beirut, Tunis, and Jerusalem. After a number of post-Foreign Service intermediate stops in private business and the government, Mark took a position at the National Defense University in Washington, DC, where he teaches economics to colonels and captains on their way to becoming generals and admirals.

Mark was first introduced to VADA/Nova in the early days of his daughter Jennifer's riding career. He remembers fondly the first few years when he would drop her off at Morven Park the day of a show, go have a cup of coffee and read the newspaper, then show up in time to watch her ride. These days, when Jennifer participates in a show, Mark is there for support throughout the whole day from early morning stall mucking to hand walking the horse afterward. As this will be Jennifer's last year in Young Riders, Mark is hoping for one more trip to the North American Championships and the Festival of Champions with his daughter.

Although Mark jokes that he doesn't need a horse as he has a daughter that comes equipped with them, the Foulon family currently has two horses. Ferrero, aka Furley, is a 15 year old Hanoverian gelding who thinks he is a dog. They have had him since he was 4. Their other horse, Mr. M, is an 8 year old of somewhat indeterminate breed. They think he may be an Estonian Sport Horse or Swedish Warmblood, although he is registered as an American Warmblood.

When not at a horse show with his daughter Mark finds he still cannot stay away, and when possible tries to volunteer for VADA/Nova. According to Mark, he has come to admire VADA/Nova for the remarkable services they provide to area riders, and tries to support the organization when he can. Through watching his daughter Jennifer ride and compete, Mark says that he has come to admire horse people by developing a true appreciation for the difficulty of the sport. He admires people that ride and compete and has developed a better understanding of the years of long days, hard work, and real pain it takes to make if all look effortless. A VADA/Nova member for several years, Mark has volunteered as a runner, golf cart driver and helped with set-up.

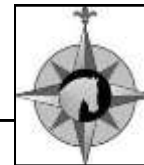
