**SUMMARY MINUTES
VADA/Nova Board Meeting
May 8, 2017-Morven Park classroom**

The meeting was called to order at 7:25 pm
There were nine Board members present, four excused, and one guest.

The minutes of the April meeting were accepted by the Board.

Treasurer's Report: Dilly reported that there was a balance of \$70,379.34(unreconciled) in the regular account. The Special Account is unchanged. The April Licensed show made a profit.

Licensed Shows: Dianne Boyd reported on the June show. An assistant secretary has been hired to help out. She will be at the show Thursday prior to the show. The generator will be rented again for the temporary stalls. Entries are coming in steadily. Instead of a Saturday night Competitors' Party, Dianne Boyd suggested we have ice cream available for everyone from 3-5 p.m.

Schooling Shows: Diann Carpenter reported that the March show made a profit, and was well attended. Homestead's two partner shows have been cancelled due to bad weather; they may reschedule these for later in the season. Diann & Michelle will go over the results from the Banquet Survey regarding the Championship Show and give the Board the feedback about those results as well as how the partner shows are working out at our next meeting.

Membership: As of tonight there were 234 members, 65 of whom paid by PayPal. PayPal is being used more and more for memberships & entries.

Chapter Challenge: This will be held August 26 in Lexington, Virginia. There will be a Musical Freestyle Stakes class with prize money. Some chapters are putting in extra money for the Stakes class; VADA/Nova will add \$100 to the pot. We will also sponsor a \$50 gift certificate for the Best Turned Out Rider/Horse. Scores from this show will count as VADA/Nova scores for Year End Awards.

Youth Team: The show this year will be held in June in Lexington in conjunction with the Rosinburg Events licensed show.



Member of the Month

Our Member of the Month for June is Judy Hunter. After leaving the Federal government where she was a computer scientist for 26 years for NASA and the Department of Defense, she enrolled in a Masters program in acupuncture. She is now an acupuncturist with a practice in Purcellville, VA. When she's not seeing clients for acupuncture, she is riding or working around horses.

To stop her constant begging, her parents finally allowed her to take riding lessons when she was 11 years old. She learned to ride western primarily on quarter horses. She was very lucky to grow up riding at a place that had fun activities every month such as breakfast rides, moonlight rides, barn dances and hay rides and her lifelong love of horses began. Judy began to show QHs and later Appaloosas in halter, western performance, western equitation, as well as gymkhana (barrel racing, pole bending, flag race, and keyhole) and continued riding western for the next 25 years.

After a couple of catastrophic accidents, Judy was certain that she was finished with horses, but she just couldn't stay away. She rescued a couple of TBs and began trail riding again. As they aged, she decided she was finished with riding, but resolved to take care of her 5 rescued horses to the end of their lives.

And then along came Zip O Doc, Judy's current little QH mare. She bought Zippa because she had the quiet disposition Judy wanted for trail riding. However, she always had a sore back and so Judy took her to a saddle fitter fully intending to buy a western saddle. Much to her surprise, Zippa was most comfortable in a dressage saddle! Knowing absolutely nothing about dressage, Judy rode in in the dressage saddle trail riding, working cows, and in judged pleasure rides. A couple of years after getting Zippa, Judy was introduced to dressage at Looking Glass Farm, where Zippa now lives and is in training, enjoying her new role as a dressage horse. Zippa thinks she will be ready to show this summer. ☺

Judy has been a member of VADA/Nova for two years and her favorite volunteer job is helping with the stabling at the shows, assisting in the creation of the stable charts and posting them in the barns a couple of days before the show and helping figure out how to solve any stabling issues that occur during the show. She finds it fun and rewarding, making sure everybody has what they need for their horses. We wish her much luck with her upcoming show season.
