GENERAL SHOW INFORMATION

- **Show Day Secretary Phone:** 301-788-0134 (no texts) **Show Day Secretary Email:** RAULINL@yahoo.com
- **Grounds Fee:** There is a mandatory \$20 grounds fee per horse. This fee is waived if the horse is stabled.
- **Day Stalls:** Day stalls are available for \$40; no overnight stabling. Bedding is NOT available.
- **Entry Fees:**
 - Regular Classes: members \$30 per ride; non-members \$40 per ride
 - Championship Classes: \$35 per ride (members only)
 - Pas de Deux - \$55 per pair (\$27.50 per rider, members only)
- **Priority for Qualifiers:** Entries for Championship classes and VADA/Nova member entries will be given priority.
- **Arenas:** Some championship classes may be held outdoors.

- **Classes:** Both non-championship and championship classes will be held at this show. A rider may ride in only championship classes (if qualified), only non-championship classes, or a combination of both.
- **Early Entry Receipt:** If an entry is received before the opening date, it will be considered received 3 days after the opening date.
- **Refunds:** Refunds will be given in full prior to the closing date. NO refunds will be given after the closing date unless a situation arises that the VADA/Nova Board of Directors deems so extraordinary as to warrant a full or partial refund. In that case, the VADA/Nova Board of Directors will determine the appropriate course of action.
- **Places:** Regular classes will be pinned to 6th place. Championship classes will be pinned to 8th place.
- **Number of Rides per Horse:** A horse may not be ridden more than three rides. The rides must be by the same rider.

QUALIFICATION FOR CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

- **Minimum Qualifying Scores:** To ride in a championship class, a horse/rider pair must have earned at least a minimum qualifying score in the Championship test, as follows:

Test	Minimum Qualifying Score
Introductory B	65%
Training 3	62%
First 3	60%
Second 3	60%
Third 3	58%
Fourth 3	58%
FEI PSG, Int I, Int A, Int B, Int II or GP)	58%
MFS (Training thru Grand Prix)	63%
Pas de Deux	63%

- **When Scores Must be Earned:** Scores must be earned from January 1, 2017 to October 22, 2017.
- **Membership:** The rider must have been a VADA/Nova member at the time the qualifying score was earned.
- **Introductory Level:**
 - Which Shows: Must earn one qualifying score at a 2017 VADA/Nova-sponsored schooling show, VADA/Nova partner schooling show, or 2017 VADA/Nova-sponsored recognized/licensed show. Scores from any other schooling show or recognized/licensed show will not count.
 - Show Experience: Riders who have competed at second level and above at any recognized/licensed or schooling show at any time on any horse must enter Intro B Section 2 Championship class
- **Training Level:**
 - Which Shows - Must earn one qualifying score at a 2017 VADA/Nova-sponsored schooling show or VADA/Nova partner schooling show. Scores from any other schooling show, VADA/Nova-sponsored recognized/licensed shows, or any other recognized/licensed shows will not count.
 - Show Experience: Riders who have competed at fourth level and above at any recognized/licensed or schooling show at any time on any horse must enter Training 3 Section 2 Championship class.
- **First Level & Above and MFS:** Which Shows - Must earn one qualifying score at a 2017 VADA/Nova-sponsored schooling show or VADA/Nova partner schooling show. Scores from any other schooling show, VADA/Nova-sponsored recognized/licensed shows, or any other recognized/licensed shows will not count.
- **Only Highest Qualified Level:** If a horse/rider pair has qualified at more than one level, they may only ride in one Championship class, which must be the highest level at which they qualified.
- **Previous Winners:** The same horse/rider pair cannot compete at a level if they have previously won the schooling show championship at that level within the past year.

RULES FOR CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

- **VADA/Nova Schooling Show Rules:** General VADA/Nova schooling show rules apply to regular and championship classes.
- **Turn-Out:** Proper turn-out is expected, including braiding of the horse.
- **NO Readers:** All championship tests must be ridden from memory – NO readers allowed.
- **NO Whips:** Whips may not be carried in Championship classes.
- **WU and Championship Rides:** For Championship classes only – the warm-up ride can be the same test as the Championship ride (i.e. a horse/rider pair may ride Training 3 as a warm-up ride and also Training 3 as a Championship ride).
- **Places:** Championship classes will be pinned to 8th place.
- **One Horse / Two Riders:** If two different riders have qualified on the same horse, only one rider may ride the horse in the show.
- **Riders:** Horses competing in Championship classes may not be ridden on the show grounds by anyone other than the rider, at any time during the show. Violation of this rule will result in disqualification from the Championship show.
- **Scores:** Riders must receive a score of 55% or higher in order to receive a Champion or Reserve Champion ribbon. Otherwise, a regular ribbon will be awarded.
- **Split or Combined Classes:** Depending upon entries, championship classes may be split or combined.
- **Entry Priority:** Riders who have qualified for the championship show will have priority in filling available slots at the show.

DIRECTIONS

- **From Beltway (I495):** West on Rte 7 to Leesburg. Take Rte 15 Bypass north for 2.5 miles. Turn left onto Rte 740 (Tutt Lane). In ½ mile, turn left onto Morven Park driveway.
- **From Fredericksburg and I-95:** North to I-495 toward Dulles Airport. Exit onto Rte 7 West. Follow directions above.
- **From Warrenton:** North on Rte 29 to Rte 15. Turn left onto Rte 15 and continue to Leesburg. Take Rte 15 bypass north. Follow directions above.

- HOW TO ENTER THE SHOW -

Send the following:

(1) completed **Entry Form**, (2) completed **Liability Release**, (3) copy of the horse's **Coggins** report that will be current on the date of the show and has the same horse name as on this entry form, (4) **check** for the total amount due (made out to **VADA/Nova, Inc.**) and (5) **Volunteer Bucks** if they will be used to pay any show fees.

If using volunteer bucks then you must send everything via regular mail and cannot use the online entry system

ENTRY CHECKLIST

- Completed **Entry Form**
- Completed **Liability Release**
- Copy of the horse's **Coggins** report that will be current on the date of the show
- Check** for the total amount of the fees (made out to **VADA/Nova, Inc.**)
- Volunteer Bucks** if they will be used to pay any show fees
- Do not mail so that it will arrive **before** the opening date.
- Do not mail with any service that requires a signature upon delivery.
- ALL documentation and payment **MUST** be received by the show secretary by midnight of the closing date.
