The following must be sent to [the secretary listed above](#): (1) completed **Entry Form**, (2) completed **Liability Release**, (3) a legible copy of the horse's **Coggins** report that will be current on the date of the show and has the same horse name as on this entry form, (4) **check** for the total amount due (made out to [VADA/Nova, Inc.](#)) and (5) **Volunteer Bucks** if they will be used to pay any show fees. **Do not mail with a signature required service**

If an entry comes in before the opening date, it will be considered received 3 days after the opening date.

Directions: From Fairfax: Rte. 50 West. Turn left onto Rte. 15 South, 4.7 miles, turn left onto Logmill Rd. (701). Continue 1.7 miles, turn R into farm entrance. **From Warrenton:** Rte. 29 North, turn left onto Rte 15 North. Follow for 17 miles, turn right onto Logmill Rd. (701). Continue 1.7 miles, turn R into farm entrance.
