**Qualification for Championship Classes:**

- Minimum Qualifying Scores:** To ride in a Championship class, a horse/rider pair must have earned the minimum qualifying score riding the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> test of the level at a 2019 VADA/Nova or VADA/Nova Partner schooling show as follows:

- For USDF tests** the qualifying score can be obtained **at either the second or third test of the level**. Please note that you will be required to ride the **SECOND** test of the level for the Championship classes.
- For FEI, USEAA, USEAA FEI, and MFS** any test can be ridden at both the schooling shows and in the Championship. Please note the Championship classes will be run as a **Test of Choice**.
- Only Highest Qualified Level:** If a horse/rider pair has qualified at more than one level, (s)he may only ride in only one Championship class. This class must be at the highest level at which (s)he qualified.
- Earning Scores:** Scores must have been earned between 1 December 2018 and 20 October 2019. Riders must earn one qualifying score at a 2019 VADA/Nova-sponsored schooling show or a VADA/Nova partner schooling show. Scores from any other schooling show or recognized/licensed show will not count.

- **Previous Winners:** The same horse/rider pair cannot compete at a level if (s)he has previously won the Championship Schooling Show at that level within the past year.
- **Membership:** The rider must have been a VADA/Nova member or non-member show pass holder at the time the qualifying score was earned.
- **For Introductory Level:**
  - Intro B Section 1—For riders who have not competed at 2nd level or above
  - Intro B Section 2—For riders who have competed at 2nd level or above
  - Riders who have competed at Second Level and above at any recognized/licensed or schooling show at any time on any horse must enter Intro B Section 2 Championship class (Class #202).
- **For Training Level:**
  - Training 2 Section 1—For riders who **have not** competed at 4th level or above
  - Training 2 Section 2—For riders who have competed at 4th level or above
  - Riders who have competed at Fourth Level and above at any recognized/licensed or schooling show at any time on any horse must enter Training 3 Section 2 Championship class (Class #204).

## Rules For Championship Classes:

- **VADA/Nova Schooling Show Rules:** General VADA/Nova schooling show rules as specified in the 2019 VADA/Nova Green Book apply to all classes at this show with the following more restrictive rules applying to Championship classes:
  - **Turn-Out:** Proper turn-out is expected, including coats for riders and braiding of the horse's mane.
  - **Readers:** All Championship tests must be ridden from memory. **No** readers are allowed in Championship classes.
  - **Whips:** Whips may **not** be carried in Championship classes.
  - **Warm Up and Championship Rides:** For Championship-qualified riders only.
  - **Placing:** Championship classes will be pinned to 8th place.
  - **One Horse/Two Riders:** If two different riders have qualified on the same horse, only one rider may ride the horse in the show.
  - **Riders:** Horses competing in Championship classes may not be ridden on the show grounds by anyone other than the rider at any time during the show. Violation of this rule will result in disqualification from the Championship Schooling Show.
  - **Scores:** Riders must receive a score of 55% or higher in order to receive a Champion or Reserve Champion ribbon. Otherwise, a regular ribbon will be awarded.
  - **Split or Combined Classes:** Depending upon entries, Championship classes may be split or combined.
  - **Entry Priority:** Riders who have entered Championship classes will have priority in filling available ride times.

- Completed liability release (<http://vadanova.org/other/forms/SchoolingLiabilityRelease.pdf>)
- A legible copy of the horse's Coggins report that will be current on the date of the show and has the same horse name as on this entry form
- A check for the total amount due (made out to VADA/Nova, Inc.)
- Volunteer Bucks if they will be used to pay any show fees
- Do not mail entries with a "signature required" service
- Online entries may also be submitted on-line via <https://www.vnstore.vadanova.org/index.php>, provided that the applicant is not paying either in full or in part with Volunteer Bucks.
- If an entry arrives before the opening date, it will be considered received three days after the opening date.

- **VADA Nova Member High Score Of Show (excludes Intro Level, Beginner Novice Eventing, and MFSs):** \$100 gift card from Tri-County Feeds (NOTE: This award is reserved for VADA Nova members. Non-Member Show Pass holders are ineligible.)
- **High Score Intro Through Training Levels (not including MFS):** \$50 gift card for VTO Saddlery
- **High Score First Through Fourth Level (not including MFS):** \$50 gift card for VTO Saddlery
- **High Score Eventing:** \$50 gift card for VTO Saddlery
- **High Score FEI (not including MFS):** \$50 gift card for VTO Saddlery
- **High Score MFS:** \$50 gift card for VTO Saddlery
- **High Score Jr/YR:** \$50 gift card for VTO Saddlery
- **High Score Adult Amateur:** \$50 gift card for VTO Saddlery
- **Overall High Score Of Show (excludes Intro Level, Beginner Novice Eventing, and MFSs):** \$50 gift card for VTO Saddlery

## Directions:

- **From Beltway/I495:** West on Route 7 to Leesburg. Take Route 15 Bypass north for 2.5 miles. Turn left onto Rt. 740 (Tutt Road). Proceed for one half mile. Turn left into Morven Park driveway.
- **From Fredericksburg and I-95:** North to I-495 toward Dulles Airport. Exit onto Route 7 West. Follow directions above.
- **From Warrenton:** North on Rt. 29 to Rt. 15. Turn left onto Route 15 and continue to Leesburg. Take Route 15 Bypass north. Follow directions above.

## Entry Checklist, If Mailing A Paper Copy of Entry:

- Completed entry form
- Completed liability release
- Copy of the horse's Coggins report that will be current on the date of the show
- Check for the total amount of the fees (made out to VADA/Nova, Inc.)
- Volunteer Bucks if they will be used to pay for show fees
- Do **not** mail the entry so soon that it will arrive *before* the opening date
- Do **not** mail the entry with a service that requires a signature upon delivery
- ALL documentation and payment **must** be received by the Show Secretary by midnight of the closing date

- Complete the on-line entry
