Qualification for Championship Classes

1. **Minimum Qualifying Scores:** To ride in a Championship class, a horse/rider pair must have earned the minimum qualifying score at a VADA/NOVA or VADA/NOVA Partner schooling show during the qualifying period specified below.

- 2. For USDF/USEF tests the qualifying score can be obtained at either the second or third test of the level. Please note that you will be required to ride the SECOND test of the level for the Championship class.
- 3. For FEI and MFS any level test can be ridden to qualify at schooling shows and the qualified level is what must be ridden in the Championship class. Please note that the Championship classes will be run as a Test of Choice.
- 4. **Earning Scores.** Scores must have been earned between 1 December 2021 and 24 October 2022. **NOTE:** Scores from the 23 October Mitchell Dressage Series may be used to qualify for the championship. This is the final competition opportunity to qualify. If you are planning to use scores from this show to qualify you MUST still enter the VN Championship **by the closing date** and

send the show secretary an email to alert him of your plans. If you do not receive a qualifying score you may either ride in an open class or scratch from the show with a full refund. Riders must earn one qualifying score at a VADA/NOVA-sponsored schooling show or a VADA/NOVA partner schooling show during this time frame. Scores from any other schooling show or recognized/licensed show *after the closing date* will not count towards championship eligibility.

- 5. **Membership.** The rider must have been a VADA/NOVA member at the time the qualifying score was earned.
- 6. For Introductory Level Championships.
 - a. Intro B Section 1—For riders who have not competed at 2nd level or above.
 - b. Intro B Section 2—For riders who have competed at 2nd level or above.
 - c. Riders who have competed at Second Level and above at any recognized/licensed or schooling show at any time on any horse must enter Intro B Section 2 Championship class (Class #202).
- 7. For Training Level Championships.
 - a. Training 2 Section 1—For riders who have not competed at 4th level or above.
 - b. Training 2 Section 2—For riders who have competed at 4th level or above.
 - c. Riders who have competed at Fourth Level and above at any recognized/licensed or schooling show at any time on any horse must enter Training 3 Section 2 Championship class (Class #204).

Rules for Championship Classes. General VADA/NOVA schooling show rules apply to all classes at this show with the following more restrictive rules applying to Championship classes:

- 1. **Turn-Out.** Proper turn-out is expected, including coats for rider. **However, braiding of the horse's mane is optional.**
- 2. **Readers.** All Championship tests must be ridden from memory. **No** readers are allowed in Championship classes.
- 3. Whips. Whips may not be carried in Championship classes.
- 4. **Warm Up and Championship Rides.** For Championship-qualified riders only. Riders may ride any test they choose as a warmup, including their championship test.
- 5. **Placing.** Championship classes will be pinned to 8th place.
- 6. **One Horse/Two Riders.** If two different riders have qualified on the same horse, only one rider may ride the horse in the show.
- 7. **Riding Two Consecutive Levels in Championship Classes.** Riders may qualify for the show and ride in Championship classes at two consecutive levels on the same horse, however, riding two non-consecutive levels on the same horse is prohibited.
- 8. **Re-Riding a Level From The Previous Year.** A rider may not re-ride a level in a Championship class if (s)he has won that level on the same horse in a Championship class in the previous year.
- 9. **Horse/Rider Combos.** Horses competing in Championship classes may not be ridden on the show grounds by anyone other than the registered rider at any time during the show. Violation of this rule will result in disqualification from the Championship Schooling Show.
- 10. **Scores.** Riders must receive a score of 55% or higher in order to receive a Champion or Reserve Champion ribbon. Otherwise, a regular ribbon will be awarded.
- 11. **Split or Combined Classes.** Depending upon entries, Championship classes may be split or combined.
- 12. **Entry Priority.** Riders who have entered Championship classes will have priority in filling available ride times.

Submitting Entries

All entries must be done through StriderPro. You may access it via the show webpage at: November Schooling Show. If you have any issues or questions, contact the management team at Schooling.Shows@vadanova.email. Entries must include payment, completed entry form, signed USEF-VA liability release, and a current Coggins to be considered complete. If you intend to use VADA/Nova Bucks to enter, you must contact the Secretary at Schooling.Shows@vadanova.email. Please note that photographed copies of Coggins reports and other documentation is often unreadable. Scanned PDFs of all paperwork is preferred over photographs.

Please contact the Schooling Show Secretary by phone or email if you cannot, or would prefer not to, submit your entry through the online system.

Entries must contain all required documentation as well as full payment to be considered complete. Entries will be confirmed by the Show Secretary. If the show fills, incomplete entries will be placed on a waiting list after complete entries, regardless of the order in which they were received. Entries that are not complete by the closing date will not be allocated ride times and the rider will not be able to compete, regardless of whether the show is full.

General

- 1. Ride times will be available on the Wednesday prior to the show at <u>November Schooling Show</u> or via email from the show Secretary.
- 2. Please bring a boombox if performing a musical freestyle and ensure a member of your party is capable and available to run it. Please contact competition management by the closing date if unable to meet this requirement.

Directions

- 1. **From Beltway/I-495:** West on Rt. 7 to Leesburg. Take Rt. 15 Bypass north for 2.5 miles. Turn left onto Rt. 740 (Tutt Road). Proceed for one half mile. Turn left into Morven Park driveway.
- 2. **From Fredericksburg and I-95:** North to I-495 toward Dulles Airport. Exit onto Rt. 7 West. Follow directions above.
- 3. **From Warrenton:** North on Rt. 29 to Rt. 15. Turn left onto Rt. 15 and continue to Leesburg. Take Rt. 15 Bypass North. Follow directions above.
