Ride times will be posted on the show website no later than noon, Wednesday, November 2, 2022.

The **Show Office** will be in the covered area between the indoor arena and the indoor warm-up arena. **Text Jon at (757) 748-6254 if you have any questions or need to make schedule changes or scratch.** The Show Office will be open 6:00 AM until 30 Minutes after the last test on Saturday, November 5th. NO horses will be permitted on the grounds unless they have registered prior to arrival with the secretary and submitted a **current negative Coggins test.**

Day Stall assignments will be emailed to you in advance and posted at the Show Office by 6:00 AM on Saturday, November 5th. ALL trailers must be on property and enter through Tutt Lane BEFORE 5 pm. Everyone exiting after 4 pm is asked to leave via Old Waterford Rd. You will have to drive past the Hoffman building, and exit through Morven's back gate. See Updated Driving Map below.

Trailer Parking. Competitors hauling in for the day may park near the indoor or in the lots near the stables. Please do not let your support team or guests park personal vehicles in the trailer parking areas.

HELMETS ARE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED, NO EXCEPTIONS!!! NUMBERS ARE REQUIRED ON YOUR HORSE AT ALL TIMES WHEN NOT IN THE STALL OR TRAILER. THIS APPLIES FROM THE TIME YOU ARRIVE AT THE SHOW GROUNDS.

DUE TO COVID-19, MASKING IS OPTIONAL IN THE BARN AND INDOOR ARENA. SOCIAL DISTANCING IS ENCOURAGED. DO NOT COME TO THE SHOW IF YOU HAVE A TEMPERATURE OF 100.4 DEGREES OR HIGHER OR IF YOU OR A MEMBER OF YOUR HOUSEHOLD EXHIBIT SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19 OR HAVE BEEN EXPOSED TO

COVID-19 WITHIN THE LAST 5 DAYS. AFTER THE SHOW IF YOU EXPERIENCE COVID-19 SYMPTOMS OR TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19, IMMEDIATELY NOTIFY THE SHOW MANAGER, RACHEL RICE, (703) 887-0507. PLEASE READ OUR VADA/NOVA COVID-19 ACTION PLAN.

Competition Rings. There is one ring—the indoor arena. See attached map

SCHOOLING will not be available at this competition. Competitors may use the indoor warm-up arena prior to their scheduled tests. Lunging is allowed in the bluestone ring, as marked on the attached map EXCEPT DURING AWARD CEREMONIES.

Food: There will be snacks and drinks available all day near the Show Secretary/Check-in Table. An assortment of lunch sandwiches will be available midday for competitors, sponsored by B.J. and Michelle Lachner. Hot Soup will be available for competitors, provided by Jon Kreitz.
