*If you include a Day Stable, it includes your grounds fee. If you don't have a stable you must pay the Ground Fee.

VADA/Nova members will be able to enter the show beginning one week before the show is open to non-members. After the initial one week VN member only period, complete entries will be taken in the order received. Non-members who wish to take advantage of the members only entry window may join VADA/Nova during this period via the VADA/Nova web site <u>HERE</u>.

Ride times will be available on the Wednesday prior to the show HERE.

Please bring your own boom box if performing a musical freestyle. You will need someone available who knows how to operate your equipment and will operate it for your test. You will need to contact the Show Secretary to determine a time for a sound check.

Relaxed Rules Classes:

VADA/Nova is offering new classes at our March and August Schooling Shows to provide a unique opportunity to riders who want exposure to a competition environment but would like assistance when riding their test or otherwise feel unready to compete in a standard schooling show. These classes are aimed at encouraging participation from riders entering their first show – or first show on a new horse; riders who have been away from showing for some time; riders who need confidence in the show ring; or riders who would like to compete above First Level but want to retain the ability to post the trot.

The "Relaxed Rules" schooling show classes are made up of three test of choice options:

- 1) COACHING OPTION. Riders entered in the Coaching Option class can ride any test and receive coaching throughout the test from their Coaches. Coaching can be done via headset (preferred) or at the rail outside the arena.
- 2) POSTING OPTION. In the Posting Option class, riders enter a test at Second Level or above (through FEI) and may do all or some of the trot work in the posting trot. No coaching allowed.
- 3) COMBINATION OPTION. In the Combination Option class, riders may both receive coaching and post any or all of the trot work.

NOTE: <u>Relaxed Rules classes must be selected on entry form.</u>

Rules:

- Rider/horse combinations entered in any Relaxed Rules class are not able to cross enter into any Regular Rules schooling show classes at this show. This rule applies ONLY to the same horse/rider combination.
- Relaxed Rules Division tests will be marked HC, and scores will not be posted.
- Relaxed Rules Division tests do not receive ribbons or prizes.
- Scores earned in this division are not eligible for qualification for the VN Schooling Show Championship or Year End Awards for VADA or VADA/Nova.
- Riders may enter multiple times in a single or any of the 3 options and may ride the same test more than once. <u>NOTE: the horse is limited to a maximum of 3 rides total.</u>
- All tack and other VN schooling show rules apply.
- If a rider wants someone else to show their horse and they want that ride to be scheduled 1st, they
 must specify on their entry form their request. Additionally, the other rider must specify the same
 request on their entry form.

Submitting Entries:

All entries must be submitted via StriderPro using the URL https://striderpro.com

Please note that photographed copies of Coggins reports and other documentation is often unreadable. Scanned PDFs of all paperwork is preferred over photographs.

Please contact the Schooling Show Secretary by phone or by emailing <u>schooling.shows@vadanova.email</u> if you are having any problems with, or questions about, the on-line entry process.

All entries must have:

- A completed entry form
- A completed liability release
- A legible copy of the horse's negative Coggins test report that will be current on the date of the show and has the same horse's name as printed on the entry form
- Proof of vaccination for Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus within 6 months of the show date, consistent with the requirements of USEF General Rule 844 (see VN Schooling Show rules for the text of the USEF Rule)
- Payment for the total amount due. Payment can be made using StriderPro or Volunteer Bucks. If you want to pay with Check or Volunteer Bucks please email Show Management using <u>schooling.shows@vadanova.email</u>

Entries must contain all required documentation as well as full payment to be considered complete. Entries will be confirmed by the Show Secretary. If the show fills, incomplete entries will be placed on a waiting list after complete entries, regardless of the order in which they were received. Entries that are not complete by the closing date will not be allocated ride times and the rider will not be able to compete, regardless of whether the show is full.

Directions:

From Beltway/I-495: West on Route 7 to Leesburg. Take Route 15 Bypass north for 2.5 miles. Turn left onto Rt. 740 (Tutt Road). Proceed for one half mile. Turn left into Morven Park driveway.

From Fredericksburg and I-95: North to I-495 toward Dulles Airport. Exit onto Route 7 West. Follow directions above.

From Warrenton: North on Rt. 29 to Rt. 15. Turn left onto Route 15 and continue to Leesburg. Take Route 15 Bypass north. Follow directions above.
