VADA and VADA/Nova VOLUNTEER INCENTIVES

Do you have questions about the VADA and VADA/Nova volunteer programs like: How is volunteer time tracked? What is it good for? What are the perks? This article will attempt to answer those questions.

In terms of VADA time (state hours), competitors are required to volunteer a day at a VADA event and half day with their local chapter for VADA Year-End Awards. Competitors can also use donated hours for Year-End Award qualification purposes.

VADA also tracks every person's volunteer time and rewards Gold (50 hours), Silver (24 hours), and Bronze (12 hours) volunteers with their own rewards at the end of the year.

Volunteering for VADA comes with perks--we have goodies for all our volunteers! Sweatshirts, caps, t-shirts, and coupons for tack stores. We feed everyone, coffee and snacks for breakfast, hot box lunches, and volunteers for evening classes get dinner. We ensure everyone is sun screened and bug sprayed or bundled up, as the seasons demand. VADA volunteers who volunteer for at least a day get a hotel room. If the volunteer books their own hotel room, they are reimbursed in the amount of the VADA

negotiated nightly hotel rate. VADA does their absolute best to cater to specific requests, health issues/requirements, and simple personal preference.

Most of us know that "volunteers are the best, we couldn't do it without you" but how does that translate in real terms? Through the 2021 season, VADA had 140 volunteers put in 2,601 hours. 950 of those hours were spent at Region 1 Championship, 820 hours were spent at Dressage at Lexington, 75 hours were needed to put on the VADA Symposium, and 466 hours were spent on VADA Board activities. This allowed 132 people to qualify for Year End Awards. In the 2021 competition year, year-end awards will be going out to 67 licensed horse/rider combinations, and 56 schooling horse/rider combinations. That's incredible and congratulations to each one of them! In 2021, 20 VADA/Nova members volunteered 425 hours which produced nine VADA VIP volunteer winners!

The VADA/Nova volunteer program is very similar to that for VADA. Competitors are required to complete 1.5 days of volunteer time for VN Year-End Awards. Donated volunteer time can also be used to qualify for year-end

awards. Each volunteer's time is tracked to determine who qualifies for Above and Beyond volunteer awards. The VN levels are PSG (2 days). Intermediaire (2.5-4.5 days), and Grand Prix (5 or more days). Volunteers are given a volunteer gift and VN bucks-5 for half day of work, 10 for a day of work. In addition to earning volunteer time at licensed and schooling shows and clinics, volunteer time and bucks can be earned by working at the banquet, writing articles for the newsletter and other functions. Bucks can be used for VN membership, the banquet, schooling shows and clinics and some vendors take them same as cash. We hold a volunteer raffle at our licensed and schooling shows. The prize is a gift card. Full day volunteers earn two chances in the raffle, half day volunteers earn one chance. VN does their best to accommodate volunteer requests. We too feed volunteers breakfast and lunch.

For 2021, VADA/Nova had 113 volunteers who donated 260 days of volunteer time. This does not include the many hours board members donated to support the organization.
