## IMPORTANT NOTES FOR THIS SHOW:

1. No stabling available.
2. No non-competes will be allowed.
3. All people entering the showgrounds are required to wear a mask at all times except when mounted.
4. Each rider may be accompanied by a **MAXIMUM** of 3 people (coach, groom, owner and/or parents for riders under 18 .)
5. **NO SPECTATORS ARE ALLOWED.**
6. If you are traveling with an individual or a group, all competitors **MUST** note on their entry who they are traveling with. This show may be scheduled to facilitate social distancing and minimize the number of people present on the grounds at any given time.
7. Open classes may be pinned at the end of the day. We will advise how ribbons will be distributed.
8. Score sheets not available within a reasonable time after the completion of a ride will be mailed, or scanned and emailed/texted, to competitors. Please make sure your contact information is provided and legible on your entry form.
9. **THERE WILL BE NO AWARDS CEREMONIES FOR THE CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES BUT THERE WILL BE A PHOTO OP AREA AVAILABLE FOR PICTURES. We ask that all competitors ensure social distancing while using the Photo Op Area.**
10. **Please withdraw by the closing date *if since entering you or anyone in your household:***
  - a. Has tested positive or has been presumed positive for COVID-19 at any time during the past 14 days;
  - b. Has been advised by a healthcare professional to self-quarantine at any time during the past 14 days;
  - c. Has been in close physical contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or who has been presumed positive for COVID-19 during the past 14 days;
  - d. Is subject to a quarantine order or a recommendation of a healthcare professional that, in either case, would make it inadvisable to attend a public event or competition;
  - e. Has, within the past 24 hours, exhibited any of the following symptoms: fever of 99.5 degrees F or greater, cough or shortness of breath.

**11. Please contact the show secretary to withdraw with a full refund if since the closing date you or anyone in your household:**

## Qualification for Championship Classes:

- Minimum Qualifying Scores:** To ride in a Championship class, a horse/rider pair must have earned the minimum qualifying score at a VADA/Nova or VADA/Nova Partner schooling show during the qualifying period, as shown below:

- For USDF/USEF tests** the qualifying score can be obtained **at either the second or third test of the level**. Please note that you will be required to ride the **SECOND** test of the level for the Championship classes.
- For FEI and MFS** any test can be ridden at both the schooling shows and in the Championship. Please note the Championship classes will be run as a **Test of Choice**.
- Earning Scores:** Scores must have been earned between 1 December 2019 and 20 October 2020, **EXCLUDING SCORES EARNED BETWEEN March 16- June 10, 2020**. Riders must earn one qualifying score at a VADA/Nova-sponsored schooling show or a VADA/Nova partner schooling show during this time frame. Scores from any other schooling show or recognized/licensed show will not count.
- Membership:** The rider must have been a VADA/Nova member at the time the qualifying score was earned.
- For Introductory Level Championships:**
  - Intro B Section 1—For riders who have not competed at 2nd level or above
  - Intro B Section 2—For riders who have competed at 2nd level or above
  - Riders who have competed at Second Level and above at any recognized/licensed or schooling show at any time on any horse must enter Intro B Section 2 Championship class (Class #202).

- **For Training Level Championships:**

- Training 2 Section 1—For riders who **have not** competed at 4th level or above
- Training 2 Section 2—For riders who have competed at 4th level or above
- Riders who have competed at Fourth Level and above at any recognized/licensed or schooling show at any time on any horse must enter Training 3 Section 2 Championship class (Class #204).

## Rules for Championship Classes:

- **VADA/Nova Schooling Show Rules:** General VADA/Nova schooling show rules apply to all classes at this show with the following more restrictive rules applying to Championship classes:
- **Turn-Out:** Proper turn-out is expected, including coats for rider. **However, braiding of the horse's mane is optional.**
- **Readers:** All Championship tests must be ridden from memory. **No** readers are allowed in Championship classes.
- **Whips:** Whips may **not** be carried in Championship classes.
- **Warm Up and Championship Rides:** For Championship-qualified riders only. Riders may ride any test they choose as a warmup, including their championship test.
- **Placing:** Championship classes will be pinned to 8th place.
- **One Horse/Two Riders:** If two different riders have qualified on the same horse, only one rider may ride the horse in the show.
- **Riding Two Consecutive Levels in Championship Classes:** Riders may qualify for the show and ride in Championship classes at two consecutive levels on the same horse, however riding two non-consecutive levels on the same horse is prohibited.
- **Re-Riding A Level From The Previous Year:** A rider may not re-ride a level in a Championship class if (s)he has won that level on the same horse in a Championship class in 2019.
- **Riders:** Horses competing in Championship classes may not be ridden on the show grounds by anyone other than the rider at any time during the show. Violation of this rule will result in disqualification from the Championship Schooling Show.
- **Scores:** Riders must receive a score of 55% or higher in order to receive a Champion or Reserve Champion ribbon. Otherwise, a regular ribbon will be awarded.
- **Split or Combined Classes:** Depending upon entries, Championship classes may be split or combined.
- **Entry Priority:** Riders who have entered Championship classes will have priority in filling available ride times.

## USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program:

Starting in 2020, VADA/Nova is a participant in the USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards program. The USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program offers regional recognition to USDF **Group Members** who are competing in non-USEF-licensed/non-USDF-recognized competitions. You **must** be a GMO member in order to participate in this program! The program runs from 1 December through 30 November each year.

Four award divisions, including Open, Junior/Young Rider, Adult Amateur, and Non-Professional will be recognized per region. The Open division will offer six levels of recognition (Training, First, Second, Third, Fourth, and FEI), with the Junior/Young Rider, Adult Amateur, and Non-Professional divisions offering an additional seventh level (Introductory).

- **Paper entries submitted via USPS can be sent to the Secretary listed above and must contain the information provided in the checklist below. DO NOT MAIL ENTRIES WITH A "SIGNATURE REQUIRED" SERVICE!**
- Online entries may also be submitted on-line via <https://www.vnstore.vadanova.org/index.php>, provided that the applicant is not paying either in full or in part with Volunteer Bucks. All information contained in the checklist below must be received either electronically or in hardcopy by the Secretary listed above before your entry is considered complete.
- Times will not be allocated to incomplete entries!

## General:

- Ride times will be available on the Wednesday prior to the show at <http://vadanova.org> or via email from the show Secretary.
- Please bring a boombox if performing a musical freestyle and ensure a member of your party is capable and available to run it.

## Directions:

- **From Beltway/I495:** West on Route 7 to Leesburg. Take Route 15 Bypass north for 2.5 miles. Turn left onto Rt. 740 (Tutt Road). Proceed for one half mile. Turn left into Morven Park driveway.
- **From Fredericksburg and I-95:** North to I-495 toward Dulles Airport. Exit onto Route 7 West. Follow directions above.
- **From Warrenton:** North on Rt. 29 to Rt. 15. Turn left onto Route 15 and continue to Leesburg. Take Route 15 Bypass north. Follow directions above.

## Entry Checklist, If Mailing A Paper Copy of Entry:

- Completed entry form
- Completed liability release
- Copy of the horse's Coggins report that will be current on the date of the show
- Check for the total amount of the fees (made out to VADA/Nova, Inc.)
- Volunteer Bucks if they will be used to pay for show fees
- Do **not** mail the entry so soon that it will arrive *before* the opening date
- Do **not** mail the entry with a service that requires a signature upon delivery
- ALL documentation and payment **must** be received by the Show Secretary by midnight of the closing date
