### Important Notes For This Show:

1. No stabling will be available.
2. Non-competing horses will not be allowed.
3. All people entering the showgrounds are required to wear a mask at all times except when mounted.
4. If traveling with others/a group, all competitors MUST annotate the name(s) of those with whom they are traveling on the entry. This show will be scheduled to facilitate social distancing and minimize the number of people present on the grounds at any given time.
5. All classes will be pinned at the end of the day. The show management team will advise how ribbons will be distributed.
6. ***Prior to 20 March, please withdraw from the show without financial penalty, irrespective of the closing date, by contacting the Show Secretary, Judy Grass, if you or anyone in your household:***
  - a. Has tested positive or has been presumed positive for COVID-19 at any time during the past 14 days;
  - b. Has been advised by a healthcare professional to self-quarantine at any time during the past 14 days;
  - c. Has been in close physical contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or who has been presumed positive for COVID-19 during the past 14 days;
  - d. Is subject to a quarantine order or a recommendation of a healthcare professional that, in either case, would make it inadvisable to attend a public event or competition;
  - e. Has, within the past 24 hours, exhibited any of the following symptoms: fever of 99.5 degrees Fahrenheit or greater, cough, or shortness of breath.
7. ***If conditions in items 6a through 6e require you to withdraw from the show on 20 March, please contact the Day of Show Secretary, Maloree Razzino.***

8. ***If you can answer “yes” to any of the conditions in 6a through 6e, above, on the day of the show, you will not be granted access to the show grounds.***
9. Competitors will be provided additional COVID-19 plans and instructions to which all must adhere throughout the duration of the competition.

Intro through Grand Prix, Para Equestrian, MFS (Training through Grand Prix), Pas de Deux, USEA Eventing, USEF Western Dressage

***For members who paid 2020 dues on or before 10 June 2020:*** the VADA/Nova Board has extended these memberships through the end of 2021.

Please bring your own boom box if performing a musical freestyle. The Show Secretary will contact you to determine proper sanitization procedures and/or confirm who will operate it for your test.

### USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program:

VADA/Nova is a participant in the USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards program. The USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program offers regional recognition to USDF **Group Members** who are competing in non-USEF-licensed/non-USDF-recognized competitions. You **must** belong to a Group Member Organization (GMO), such as VADA/Nova, in order to participate in this program! The program runs from 1 December through 30 November each year.

Four award divisions, including Open, Junior/Young Rider, Adult Amateur, and Non-Professional will be recognized per region. The Open division will offer six levels of recognition (Training, First, Second, Third, Fourth, and FEI), with the Junior/Young Rider, Adult Amateur, and Non-Professional divisions offering an additional seventh level (Introductory).

### Submitting Entries:

The preferred method of entry is via the VADA/Nova website. The URL is <https://www.vnstore.vadanova.org/index.php>.

***Please note that photographed copies of Coggins reports and other documentation is often unreadable. Scanned PDFs of all paperwork is preferred over photographs.***

Entries may also be submitted via the U.S. Postal Service or the VADA/Nova website.

To enter via the U.S. Postal Service, the following must be mailed to the Show Secretary listed above:

- A completed entry form

- A completed liability release  
(<http://vadanova.org/other/forms/SchoolingLiabilityRelease.pdf>)
- A legible copy of the horse's negative Coggins test report that will be current on the date of the show and has the same horse name as printed on the entry form
- A check for the total amount due (made out to VADA/Nova, Inc.) or Volunteer Bucks if they will be used to pay show fees
- Do not mail USPS mail with a "signature required" service.

Entries must contain all required documentation as well as full payment to be considered complete. Entries will be confirmed by the Show Secretary. If the show fills, incomplete entries will be placed on a waiting list after complete entries, regardless of the order in which they were received. Entries that are not complete by the closing date will not be allocated ride times and the rider will not be able to compete, regardless of whether the show is full.

### Directions:

From Beltway/I-495: West on Route 7 to Leesburg. Take Route 15 Bypass north for 2.5 miles. Turn left onto Rt. 740 (Tutt Road). Proceed for one half mile. Turn left into Morven Park driveway.

From Fredericksburg and I-95: North to I-495 toward Dulles Airport. Exit onto Route 7 West. Follow directions above.

From Warrenton: North on Rt. 29 to Rt. 15. Turn left onto Route 15 and continue to Leesburg. Take Route 15 Bypass north. Follow directions above.
